BACKGROUND:

The Florida Department of Financial Services received Homeland Security grant funding to support Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Task Forces throughout the state. The task forces support state and local emergency responders' efforts to locate victims and manage recovery operations in the event of a natural disaster. Additionally, the funding is to support WMD Hazardous Material (HazMat) Teams in their efforts to respond to events involving such materials.

As a member of the Central Florida USAR Team and a primary participant in regional emergency response, Seminole County has been allocated \$517,571.00 in reimbursement funds for USAR and HazMat related training (\$140,721.00) and equipment purchases (\$376,850.00).

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute a Resolution implementing Budget Amendment Request (BAR) #10-01 through the Public Safety Grant Fund in the amount of \$517,571.00 to allocate funding from the U.S.Department of Homeland Security's State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP).
