BACKGROUND:

Seminole County administers the Community Service Block Grant Program funds from the Department of Health and Human Services under 42 USC 9901-9921 and Florida Administrative Code Chapter 9B-22 through the CSBG Advisory Board. The Purpose of the program is to provide assistance for the reduction of poverty, the revitalization of low-income communities, and the empowerment of low-income families and individuals in rural and urban areas to become self-sufficient.

Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) funding has been granted to Seminole County since FY 87/88. The acceptance and use of CSBG funds requires an Advisory Board of Directors (Board) which is comprised of the following:

- a. One-third (1/3) of the members of the Board as elected officials currently holding office (or their representative);
- b. One-third (1/3) of the members as persons chosen in accordance with the demographic selection procedures (Town Meetings) to assure representation from target areas;
- c. One-third (1/3) of the Board as representatives from the private sector, officials or members of business, labor, industry, religious or other major groups in the community.

This Advisory Board meets bi-monthly to review the progress of the CSBG Program and to assist staff in planning program activities.

Staff is requesting the Board of County of Commissioners to approve the following representatives for the CSBG Advosory Board:

- In District 1, the appointment of William Jackson, Jr. to represent the Target Area of Oviedo for the remaining term: August 8, 2009 –March 11, 2010. Mr. Jackson was elected by his community on August 8 2009, to fill the vacancy left by Danny McKinney who resigned due to a conflict of interest.

- In District 3, the re-appointment of Commissioner Sarah Reese which was approved by the City of Altamonte Springs City Council for the term of June 1, 2009 through June 1, 2011.
- In District 3 representing the Low Income areas, Valerie Ford was approved for re-election for term October 9, 2009 through October 9, 2011 by the City of Altamonte Springs.
- Representing the private sector, Joyce Hinton was approved for re-election for term October 26, 2009 through October 26, 2011 by Workforce of Central Florida.
- Representing the private sector, Captain Kip Beachman was appointed and approved by the Board of County Commissioners on October 27, 2009 for the term of August 22, 2009 through August 22, 2011 to fill the vacancy left by Marie Carling, Seminole County Sheriff's Office.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to appoint the representatives listed for the CSBG Advisory Board.
