BACKGROUND:

Funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) offers the Repetitive Flood Claim Program to implement projects that eliminate the risk of future flood damages and claims to the National Flood Insurance Fund.

On January 13, 2009, the Board approved for staff to submit an application for this grant in response to a request from the property owner residing at 540 Orange Boulevard in Sanford.

Staff received notification that the grant was awarded in the amount of \$150,065 for the project. The project entails acquisition of the property and demolition of the home. Also, the property would be zoned as a wetland or park as required by FEMA acquisition guidelines.

This is a non-matching grant.

Staff recommends that the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute a Resolution implementing Budget Amendment Request (BAR) #10-17 through the Public Safety Grant Fund in the amount of \$150,065.00 to allocate funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency through a sub-grant agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management's Repetitive Flood Claim Program.
