BACKGROUND:

There are currently three Boys and Girls Club serving approximately 700 youths throughout Seminole County. These clubs play a vital role in the development of impressionable boys and girls, helping them realize their full potential as productive and responsible citizens. By reaching these children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement, Boys and Girls Clubs provide a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs and other negative influences that affect our youth today. The Sheriff's Office is a strong supporter of community based youth programs such as those provided by the Boys and Girls Club and therefore desires to contribute \$1,000.00 in Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies to the Boys and Girls Clubs of Seminole County.

This request complies with Chapter 932.7055(4)(a), Florida State Statutes. The State/Local uncommitted Forfeiture Fund Cash Balance prior to this commitment is \$52,450.00.
