Approval by the Board of County Commissioners to expend \$500.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide for a contribution to various crime prevention and education programs operated by the Seminole County NAACP branch.

BACKGROUND:

The Seminole County Sheriff's Office is requesting an expenditure from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund in the amount of \$500 to provide funding for various crime prevention and education programs operated by the Seminole County branch of the NAACP. One such program, the Back to School/Stay in School Program is designed to increase the number of skilled and literate youth graduating from high school. The program provides mentoring, remedial assistance and incentives for maintaining regular school attendance.

The Sheriff's Office supports the efforts of the Seminole County NAACP Branch and the various programs it administers and sponsors. Providing funding in the amount of \$500 will assist the NAACP in the continued operation of Back to School/Stay in School program and similar programs operated by the Seminole branch.

This request complies with Chapter 932.7055(4)(a), Florida State Statutes. The State/Local uncommitted Forfeiture Fund Cash Balance prior to this commitment is \$ 130,256.30.
