**BACKGROUND:**

Seminole County TRIAD is a not for profit organization that facilitates the collaborative partnership between law enforcement, fire and medical personnel, hospitals, and seniors clubs and organizations to enhance first responder services to senior citizens. During disasters such as the 2004 hurricanes, members of the TRIAD partnership provided critical services to Seminole County seniors including well being checks, assistance with medical needs, and providing transport to shelters. Seminole County TRIAD is now attempting to purchase medical identification refrigerator magnets that will allow first responders to quickly identify the medical conditions of senior citizens living in a housing unit. This product will save valuable time for first responders attempting to assist the elderly. The Sheriff's Office supports the efforts of Seminole County TRIAD and desires to contribute \$5,000 to the partnership utilizing Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies.

This request complies with Chapter 932.7055(4)(a), Florida State Statutes. The State/Local uncommitted Forfeiture Fund Cash Balance prior to this commitment is \$21,256.57.
